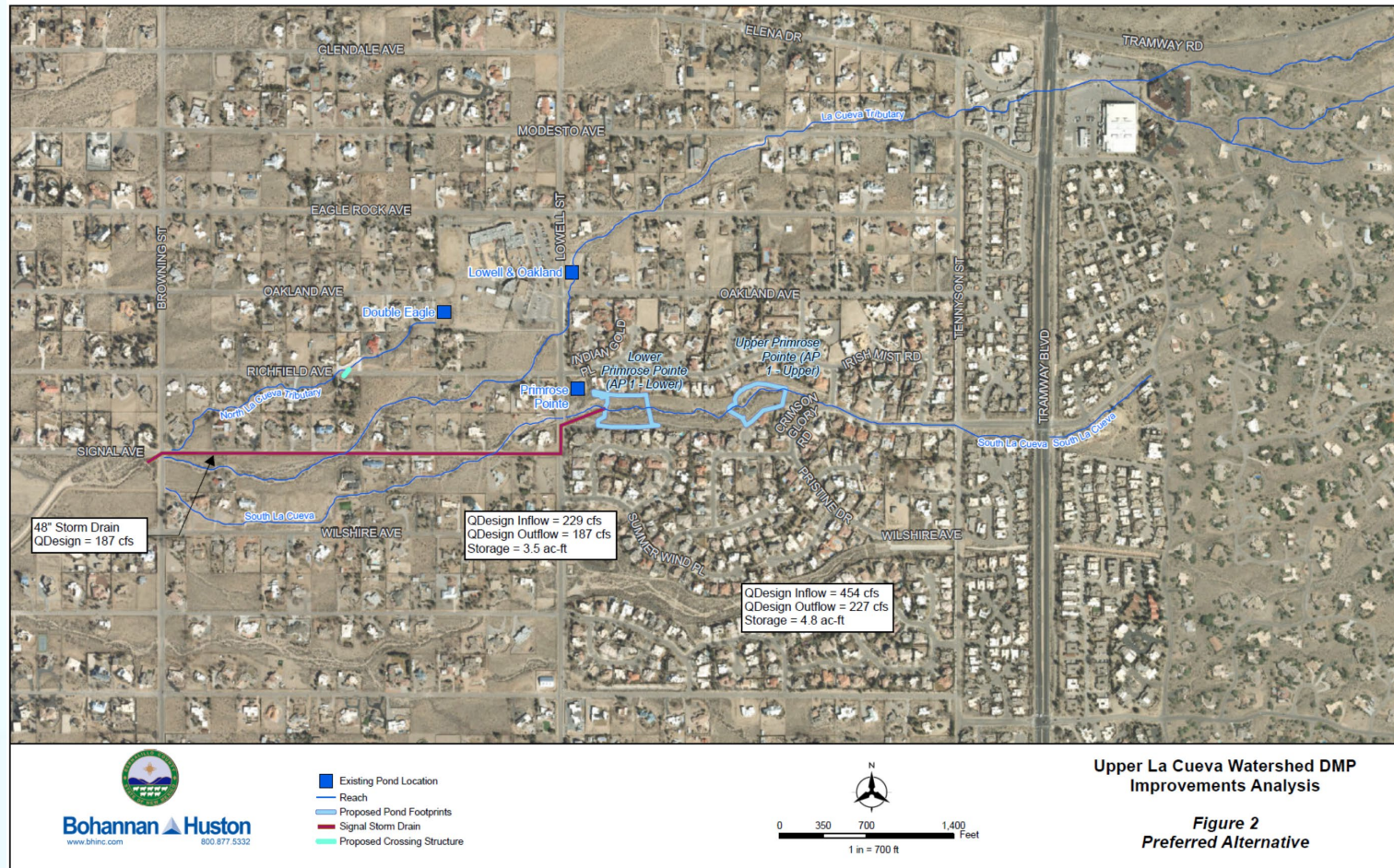

- Project: Study and design and construction of watershed improvements in the Upper La Cueva Watershed
- Project Need/Objectives: Reduce operation & maintenance costs, improve resilience of existing infrastructure,
- Funding: Federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)

Project Scope – Study Phase

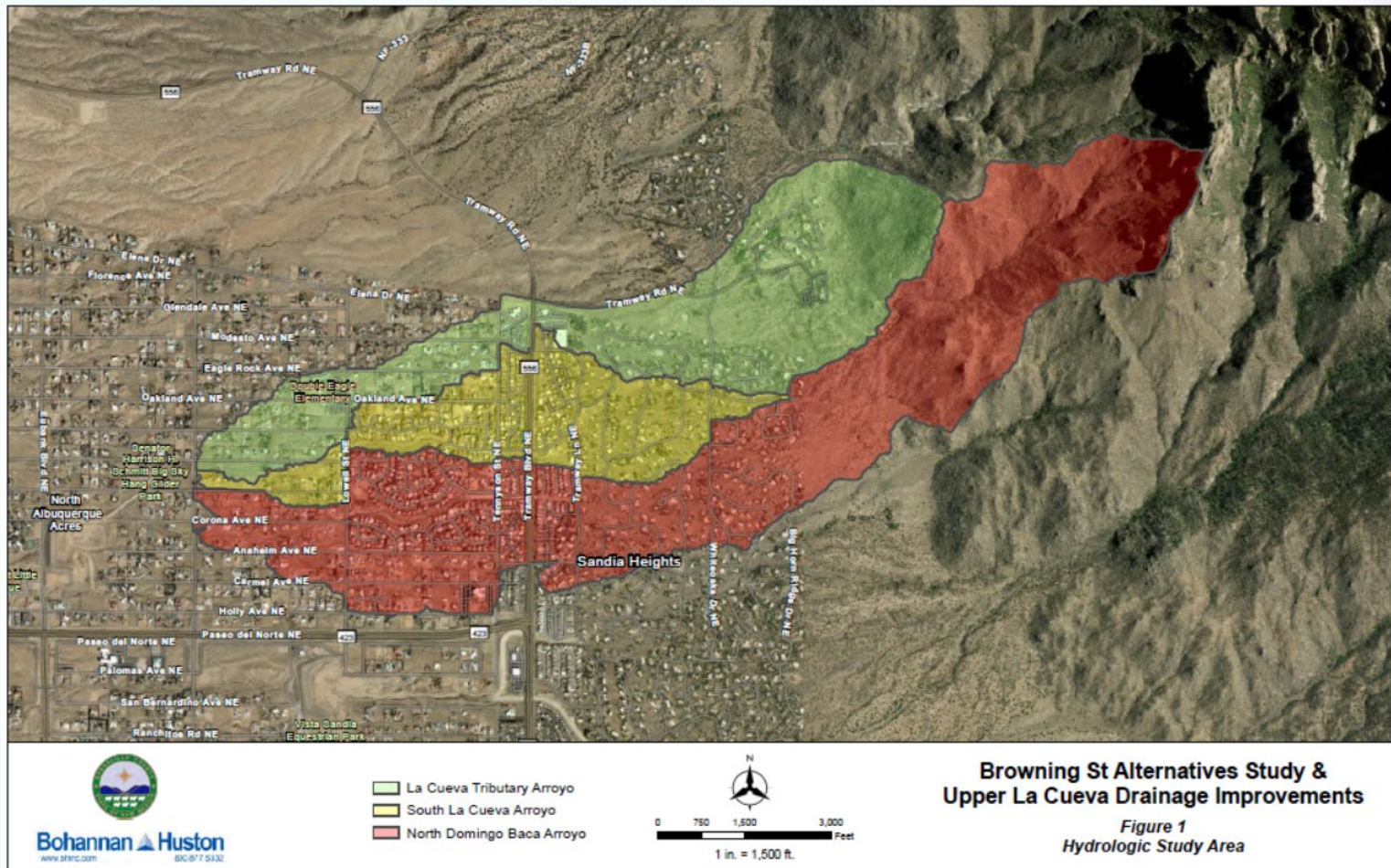
- Data Collection and Field Inventory

Project Scope – Study Phase

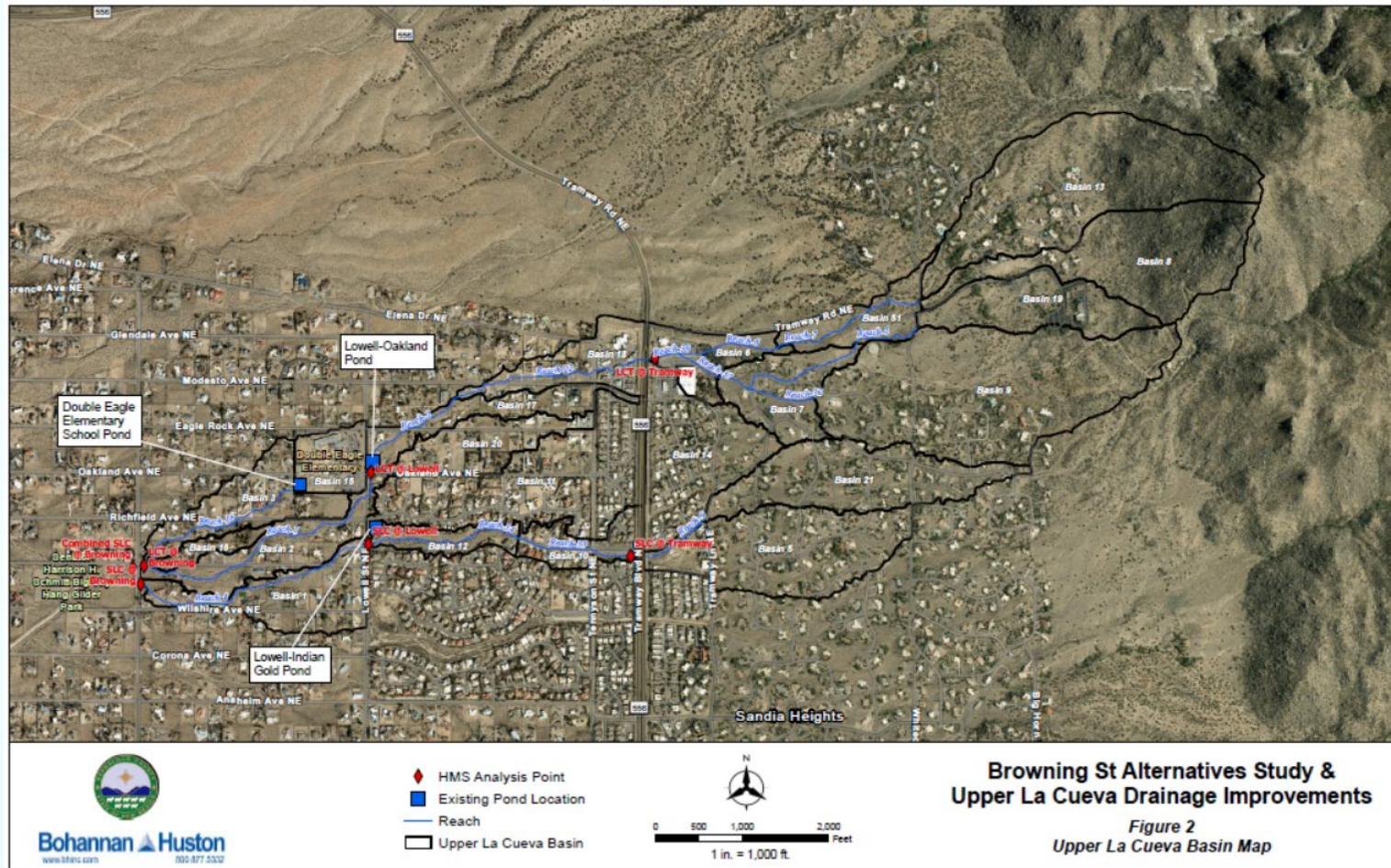
- Hydrologic & Hydraulic Analysis
 - Hydrologic models using current AMAFCA and County standards
 - Hydraulic models of area arroyos

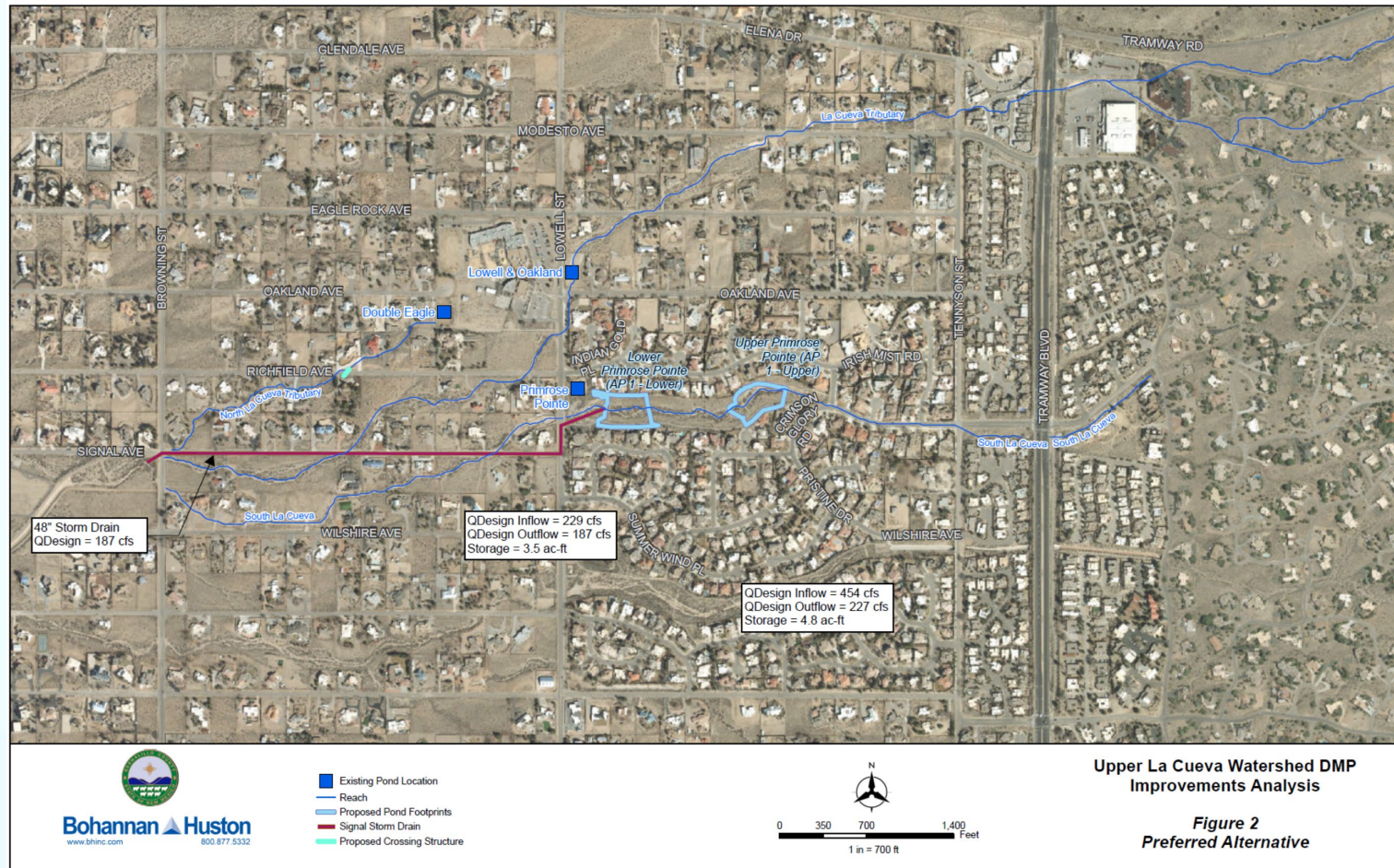

Recommended Improvements



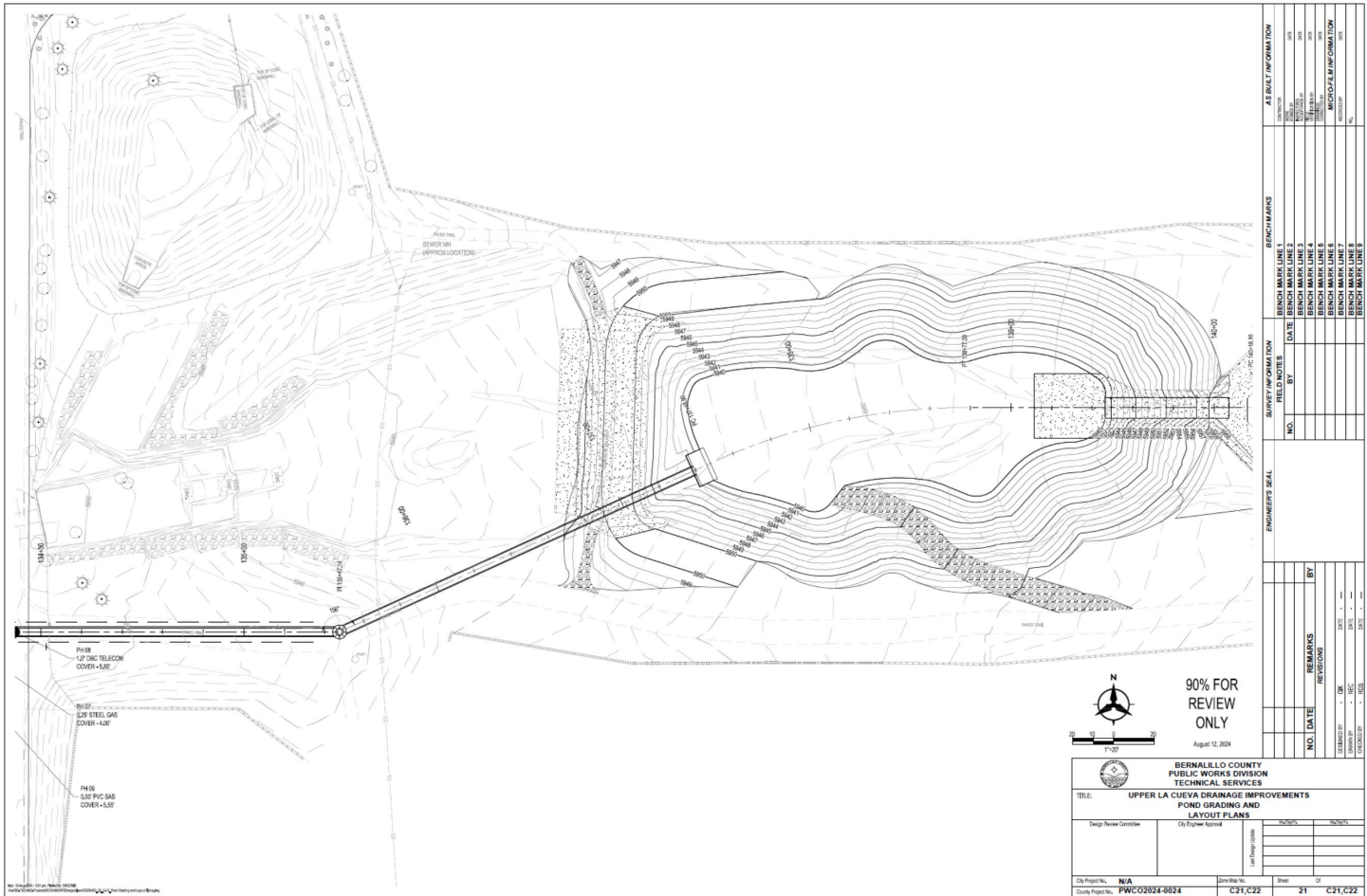
Project Scope – Design Phase

- Additional Data Gathering, Field Survey and Subsurface Utility Engineering
- Geotechnical Analysis
- Environmental Analysis
- 60% Design
- 90% Design
- Final Design



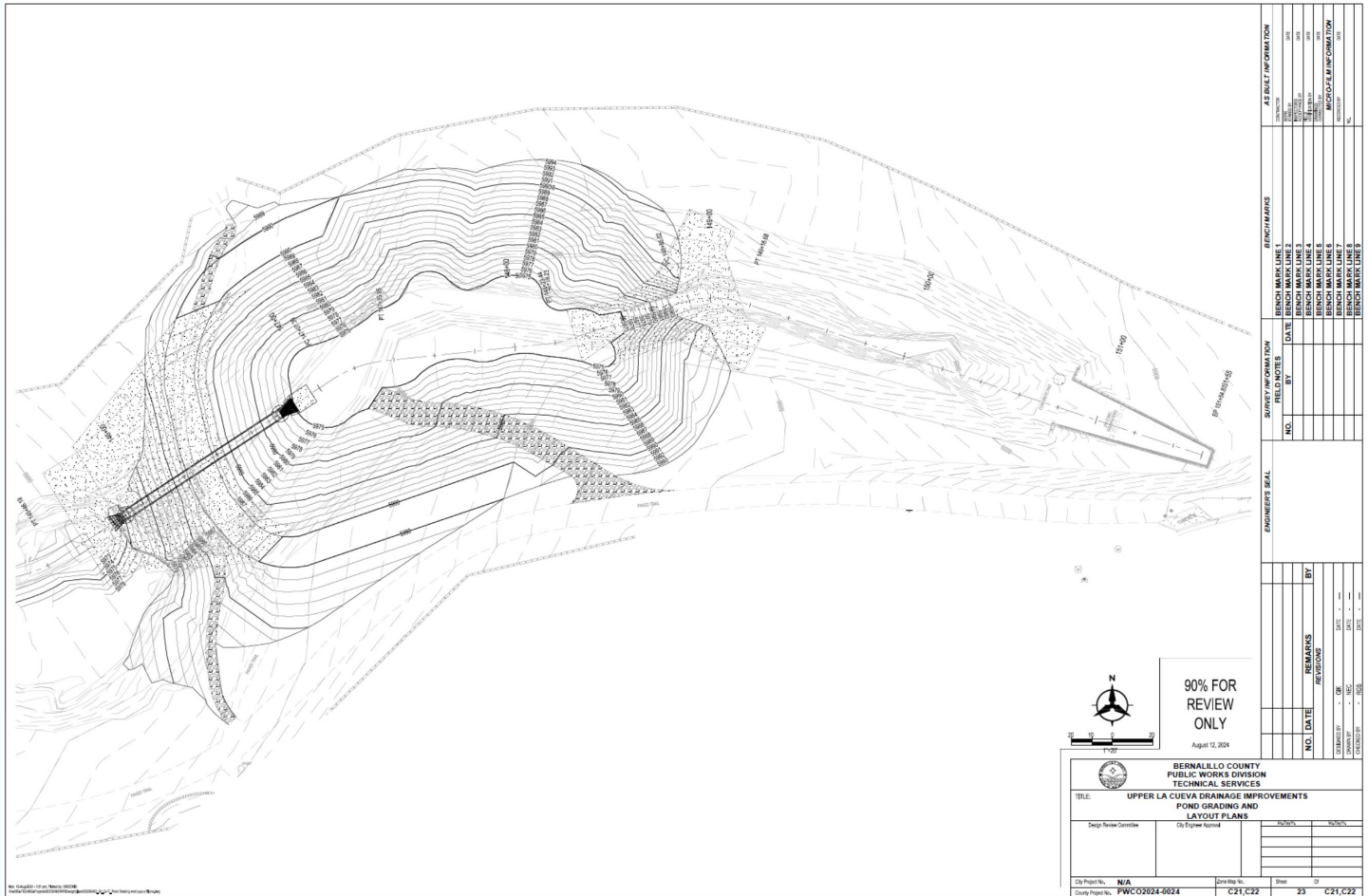
Project Scope – Design Phase

Project Scope – Construction Phase

- Potential construction impacts
 - Along roadways
 - Along arroyo – through Primrose Pointe
- Design efforts to minimize construction impacts
 - Keeping one lane on Signal open
 - Limited road closures
 - Minimizing pond sizes
 - Limiting areas that can be disturbed
- County and Contractor will work to minimize impacts during construction



Project Benefits Summary

- Reduced sediment transport
- Reduced sediment impacting area roads
- Reduced damages to property and infrastructure due to flooding
- Reduced operation & maintenance costs
- Improved stormwater quality
- Improved resilience of existing infrastructure

Next Steps

- Finalize project design – late fall
- Obtain necessary permits for construction – late fall
- Advertise for construction – early winter
- Project construction – early 2025
