PROJECT BACKGROUND

A Feasibility Study was completed in 2023 to address the following along San Ygnacio Rd & Tapia Blvd:

Inadequate roadway drainage

Implement accommodations for pedestrians and bicyclists

PROJECT PHASES

Phase IA

Tapia Blvd – San Ygnacio Rd to Robertson Ave

60% Design currently complete

Construction Funding currently unavailable

Phase IB

San Ygnacio Rd – Arenal Acequia to Goff Rd

Tapia Blvd – Trocadero Pl to San Ygnacio Rd
(Future Design)

Phase II & III

San Ygnacio Rd

Atrisco Acequia – Arenal Acequia

Foothill Dr – Arenal Acequia
(Future Design)

EXISTING ROADWAY SECTION

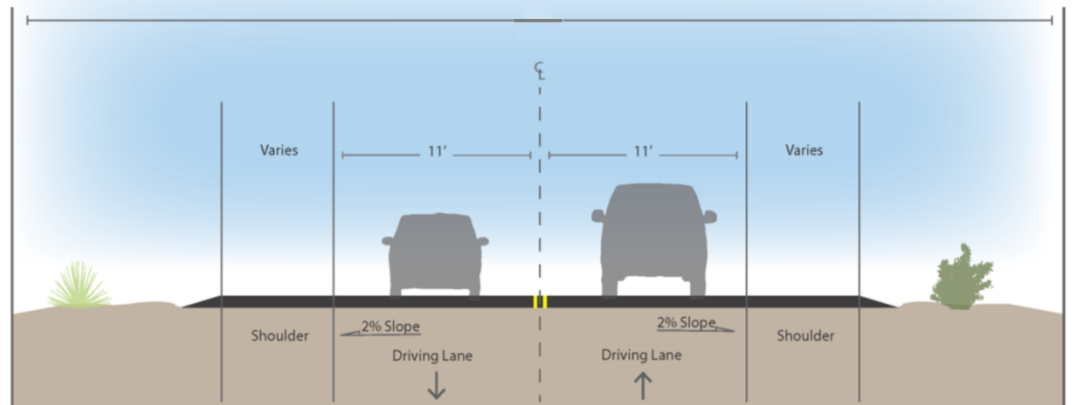
Drainage ponding on side of the road

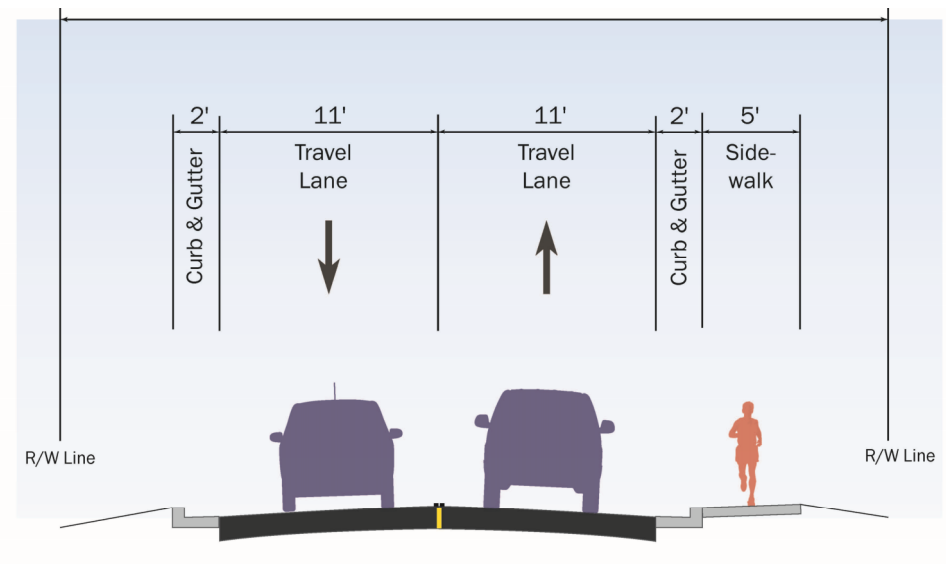


PROPOSED ROADWAY SECTION

Two 11' driving lanes

Sidewalks
(East side only)

Curb and gutter



To include the sidewalk on the north end of Tapia Blvd, right of way acquisition will be needed on the east side of the street near the intersection of San Ygnacio Rd. The exact width has not been determined yet but is between approximately 5 to 15 feet adjacent to the street.
